# AIMS OF THE YOUNG SCIENTIST COMMITTEE

**Encourage Young Scientists to join the IATDMCT and to participate (actively) in the biennial meetings.**

## **Proposals:**

## **Proposals:**

- Establish a Young Scientists corner on the website.

## **Proposals:**

- Encourage discussion of interesting TDM and CT cases and their publication in TDM journal.
